Action Items	A. Approval: Walter Park Playground Design Director Hamilton said the Parks & Facilities Committee met on June 22 to review playground design options. This playground design is a result of their review and recommendation. No public bid is needed for this product because it is assigned government pricing via a national purchasing program (HGAC). The District enrolled in HGAC in 2021 to take advantage of product pricing within the program. Purchasing ourselves, not through the general contractor who will perform the park renovation and playground installation, saves the Park District approximately 7-10% of the purchase price. Cost of Playground: \$75,608.
