1. Juli to Oluci	Commissioner Jeffery called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

4. Changes to the Agenda	Commissioner Sokolowski asked for the 2 nd Quarter Treasurers Report to be moved to Discussion item 6D prior to being ratified. Commissioner Gramann noted she was not in attendance at the July 10 Special Meeting. The approval for those minutes will be moved to the next meeting.							
5. Consent Agenda	Commissioner Powers made a motion to accept the consent agenda as amended. Seconded by Commissioner Sokolowski. A. Approval: Special Minutes: March 1, 2024 B. Approval: Regular Minutes: July 8, 2024 C. Approval: Special Minutes: July 10, 2024 D. Ratify: July 2024 Bills E. Ratify: Treasurers Report 2 nd Quarter Voice Vote. All in favor, none opposed. Motion Passes 7-0-0. Commissioner Witteck made a motion to approve the consent agenda as read. Seconded by Commissioner Gramann. Roll Call Vote: Commissioner Bird: Aye Commissioner Powers: Aye Commissioner Gramann: Aye Commissioner Sokolowski: Aye Commissioner Jeffery: Aye Commissioner Witteck: Aye Commissioner Parisi: Aye Motion Passes 7-0-0							
6. Discussion Items	A. Bike Security at Coral Cove Water Park Executive Director Rini was asked to review the steps that have been taken to prevent bicycles from being stolen from Coral Cove Water Park. Executive Director Rini shared that they have no record of bikes that were locked being stolen; only those unlocked. We have also considered a bike lock 'check-out' program, but that still requires kids to act to borrow the lock. This is a good time to revisit this conversation, prior to preparing for the 2025 budget. Commissioner Sokolowski asked about the number of bike thefts this season							



and the effectiveness of current signage. Commissioner Jeffery mentioned that security cameras at her workplace were rarely useful to police. Commissioner Sokolowski shared a personal story about learning responsibility by paying for a bike he forgot to lock. Commissioner Bird agreed we should look into getting cameras, but is concerned about drawbacks. Executive Director Rini noted that reviewing video footage is extremely time consuming. We will check with the police to check the theft statistics, look into the cost of adding a camera to the water park entrance, and have corporate counsel review the liability issue.

- B. Performance Against Organizational Goals Second Quarter Executive Director Rini reviewed the District and Departmental Goals completed during the Second Quarter. The Commissioners liked getting the update. Commissioner Sokolowski asked about the weed management goal; there have been no updates during the past two quarters.
- C. Capital Improvement Plan 2nd Quarter Update
 Executive Director Rini reviewed the Capital Improvement Plan. Our goal is to self-fund all capital improvements moving forward. We will ask the Board to review the priorities again in October, as many projects have been completed. Commissioner Sokolowski asked that projects that have been completed are marked as done on the CIP report.
- D. Treasurers Report 2nd Quarter Commissioner Sokolowski suggested that with two new board members being seated next spring, the Treasurers Report should be presented in a Finance Committee Meeting and then presented to the Board for approval. Commissioner Jeffery and others agreed. Commissioner Sokolowski made a motion to ratify the 2nd Quarter Treasurers Report. Seconded by Commissioner Powers. Roll call vote, none opposed. Motion approved 7-0-0.
- D. Weekly Happenings (oral)
 - Commissioner Gramann noted positive feedback on Facebook about pickleball in the Park District. Commissioner Sokolowski shared what he learned about an ATP (around the pole) move that exists in professional pickleball, finding it is uncommon. Commissioner Bird measured the pitch at Walter Park, ensuring it allows for water run-off. It is not enough to impact the game. Commissioner Witteck inquired about neighbor complaints, but Division Manager Kenny confirmed there have been none; the courts are popular.
 - Commissioner Jeffery noted the new Simkus marquee picture looked worse than the old one. Commissioner Sokolowski said the pictures can look very pixelated. Executive Director Rini will look into it.
 - Commissioner Parisi proposed adding batting cages at McCaslin Park, noting community interest and potential donations. Commissioner Sokolowski mentioned similar cages in other districts lost popularity over time. Commissioner Witteck agreed, adding that batting cages at West Chicago Park District are not used often. Division Manager Kenny noted



that while the addition wouldn't generate much revenue, it would enhance the park, which currently lacks warm-up space. He already has a meeting scheduled with the Travel Baseball program to discuss batting cages. Executive Director Rini explained that based on conversations with Travel Baseball and any funding needed from the District, this could become a Capital Project that the Board will rank in a future priority exercise. Commissioner Witteck brought up the noise complaint about McCaslin from an individual who previously complained about music at Coyote Crossing Mini Golf. Commissioner Sokolowski expressed concern about her taking videos at the park. Executive Director Rini confirmed that the District continues to follow all ordinances and regulations related to music. Corporate counsel has also addressed the complainant. • Commissioner Witteck commented on all the theme nights being rolled out at Coyote Crossing Mini Golf. Lots of great ideas! • Commissioner Witteck shared a compliment about Adult Trip program. There was discussion about benefits of the District's 39 passenger bus and its usage for summer camp, and for adult trips; having a bus keeps costs down. The challenge is hiring drivers with a CDL and passenger endorsement. We are not aware of any other Districts in the area with their own bus. This is something to consider during our CIP priority exercise in October. • Commissioner Witteck asked if the Board would be involved in the next Staff Appreciation event. Executive Director Rini said the Mini Golf event is scheduled in September and the Board will be invited to attend. Commissioner Jeffery attended the National Night Out in Wheeling where she works. She talked to someone who also works in Wheeling and lives in Carol Stream. She encouraged him to complete the volunteer application. Executive Director Rini informed Commissioners of plans to solicit candidates for two board positions that will become available next spring when Commissioners Sokolowski and Gramann retire. 8. Action Items A. Approval: Affiliate Agreement with Carol Stream Youth Travel Basketball Executive Director Rini said the changes to the agreement have been highlighted. Participants will pay a higher fee to offset the Park District taking on the scheduling function for the Affiliate. Commissioner Powers said the wording could be stronger on page 12. Executive Director Rini said it was reviewed by corporate counsel. Commissioner Bird made a motion to approve the 2024-2025 affiliate agreement with the Carol Stream Youth Travel Basketball Association. Seconded by Commissioner Parisi. Voice vote. All in favor, none opposed. Motion passes. B. Ordinance No. 579 Annexing Certain Property to the Carol Stream Park District Executive Director Rini said this is the property on the corner of Lies Road and

Fair Oaks. We will annex the property and receive cash-in-lieu based as



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	building permits are submitted. These funds can be used to improve Appomattox Park which is slated for renovation in 2026. Commissioner Gramann asked if we could annex the homes north of that location. Executive Director Rini will look into that. Commissioner Sokolowski made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 579, an Ordinance annexing certain property located at 1475 W. Lies Road (commonly known as Villas at Fair Oaks) to the Carol Stream Park District. Seconded by Commissioner Gramann. Parks and Facilities Committee Meeting Minutes

August 21, 2024 7:35 – 9:05 am

Topic: Pleasant Hill Park

Executive Director Rini called the meeting to order at 7:35am and provided a recap of how the project came to be.

Christian Stanford laid out the plans that had been drafted from input from Park District staff and Pleasant Hill School/District 200 staff. Lara Barnas answered question from the staff and board. Takeaways included:

- Cost estimates were based on current market conditions and include contingency.
- Some items will be designated as owner responsibility (rather than contractor) to reduce costs.
- This is an attractive OSLAD Grant applicant; maximum grant is \$600,000.
- Parking lot is an alternate, but all feel it needs to be done.
- Committee suggests moving basketball to the south. See what residents say.
- Consider berm at the North side of the courts.
- Mix tot swing with ADA swing. Playground geared towards 5-12 year olds.
- Shade from a player sport benches at Pickleball is good.
- Communicate with School District 200 as prices are refined; higher contribution is likely needed for amenities that are more beneficial to them.
- Benches could be donated by Foundation or Rotary.
- Commissioner Sokolowski encouraged reaching out to legislators for support.

A Community Input Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, August 22 at Pleasant Hill Park. Once all input is received, Hitchcock will refine the plan. It will be brought back to this Committee on September 4 for final approval.

Parks and Facilities Committee Zoom Meeting Minutes

September 4, 2024 8:00 – 8:50 am

Topic: Pleasant Hill Park

Executive Director Rini called the meeting to order at 8:00am and gave a history of the project, including the proposed partnership with District 200. Because D200 can't commit to more than 50% of the playground (or \$250,000), tennis courts will not be possible. We had previously told the School District that we would be hard pressed to keep tennis courts if pickleball was most desired by the public – which is what is the case. Tennis was requested by school teachers because it is one of their physical education modules. Including tennis would require expansion of the existing court area and not allow us to use the current fencing (which is in very good condition).

Lara Barnas reviewed the results of the Community Meeting, and gave an overview of the final park design. The most popular park elements requested were:

- #1 Pickleball (significant highest number of votes)
- #2 Net climber
- #3 Play structure with towers
- #4 Play equipment with fitness or challenge elements
- #5 Swings

Avid pickleball players live right behind the proposed courts; they are excited about courts being added to the park. The Committee also discussed options for a fifth recreational element other than 'Corn Hole'; that included 4-square, or a 16x16 pavilion. Hitchcock will include those comments in grant application to allow for exchanging the amenity once we move to creating the bid documents.

Time is critical to get design approved to meet the September 13 grant application deadline. The Committee agreed to move forward with this plan and to include the parking lot as part of the master plan rather than it being an alternate. That would bring the total project to approximately \$1.2 million and potentially capture the maximum \$600,000 OSLAD Grant match.

We will also include notation that an alternate recreation component (like a shelter/4-square) may be made. Hitchcock will gather estimates for the shelter as well as filling in concrete between cornhole/bags game for 4-square.

Bench seating is planned to the west of the courts; staff will look into adding shelters at a later date but not as part of this plan. Hitchcock will update the budget estimate and share. Rough numbers are:

\$600,000	OSLAD
\$250,000	School District 200
\$100,000	CSPD Special Recreation Fund
\$ 90,000	CSPD Paving & Lighting Fund
\$185,000	CSPD Capital Fund
\$1,225,000	TOTAL BUDGET

The Committee was pleased with the plan.

Issue

Shall the Board repeal Ordinance 467 and 468 and approve Ordinance No. 577 to accept quit claim deed from the Village of Carol Stream, and Ordinance No. 578 approving a plat of dedicated roadway easement to the Village of Carol Stream that includes portions of Chippewa Trail, Niagara, and Napa Streets.

Background/Reasoning

On June 11, 2011, the Carol Stream Park District, DuPage County, and the Village of Carol Stream entered into an IGA to transfer ownership and provide for long term use of certain properties in a cooperative effort for a storm water retention initiative at Armstrong Park. In reviewing the documents as part of the recent Klein Creek Stabilization Project, an error in the legal description of the parcel and paperwork was discovered.

The Village and Park District, in line with each entities Corporate Counsel, have established steps to correct the error. These ordinances align with that plan for correction.

ORDINANCE NO. 577

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING IT NECESSARY OR CONVENIENT FOR THE CAROL STREAM PARK DISTRICT TO USE, OCCUPY OR IMPROVE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF CAROL STREAM FOR PUBLIC PARK AND RECREATION PURPOSES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 467

WHEREAS, the Carol Stream Park District, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Park District"), an Illinois park district and unit of local government, is authorized under the Illinois Park District Code, 70 ILCS 1205/8-1(b)(1), to acquire, hold and improve real property for its corporate purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Carol Stream (the "Village"), DuPage County, Illinois is the owner of certain real property in DuPage County, Illinois, legally described in Exhibit A attached hereto and included herein (the "Property"), that is improved with a baseball field located at the intersection of Chippewa Trail and Niagara Street, Carol Stream, Illinois, and commonly known as Field 1, Ray Nazillian Field, and which the Village has agreed to transfer to the Carol Stream Park District contingent upon the Carol Stream Park District dedicating 1.63 acres of right of way to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Park District has determined that it is necessary or convenient and within the corporate purposes of the Park District for it to acquire, use, occupy and improve the Property for public park and recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Park District and the Village are municipalities as defined in the Local Government Property Transfer Act, 50 ILCS 605/0.01 et seq., which allows for the transfer of real property interests from one municipality to another upon a 2/3 vote of the corporate authorities of the transferor municipality and certain other conditions including approval by the corporate authorities of the transferee municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution in Article VII Section 10 and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq., authorizes and encourages units of local government such as the Park District and the Village to cooperate in the exercise of governmental functions and services; and

WHEREAS, the territory of the Park District is wholly within, co-extensive with, or partly within and partly without the corporate limits of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Park District previously passed Ordinance No. 467 to accomplish this transfer of property pursuant to the Act but the legal description set forth in that Ordinance was in error and therefore Ordinance No. 467 should be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Carol Stream Park District, DuPage County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The Board of Park Commissioners of the Carol Stream Park District

("Park Board") hereby finds and declares that all recitals in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and are hereby incorporated in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Ordinance No. 467 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: The Park Board hereby declares that it is necessary or convenient and in the public interest of the Park District for the Park District to acquire, use, occupy and improve the Property for public park and recreation purposes.

SECTION 4: Legal counsel for the Village is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the proposed deed transferring the Property, a draft of the plat of dedication as described in the Intergovernmental Agreement, and such other documents as may be necessary, all in consultation with the Executive Director of the Park District for presentation to legal counsel for the Park District and, upon the approval of the Park District's legal counsel, the President and Secretary of the Board of Commissioners, and the Park District's legal counsel, are authorized and directed to execute such documents and to take such actions as may be necessary to perfect the transfer of the Property and carry out the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 578 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PLAT OF ROADWAY DEDICATION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 468

WHEREAS, the Park Board approved an intergovernmental agreement between the Village, the Carol Stream Park District and DuPage County regarding the Armstrong Park-Klein Creek Flood Control Project; and

WHEREAS, as part of that agreement, the Village agreed to transfer an open space parcel situated in the north portion of Armstrong Park to the Carol Stream Park District for development as future recreational land; and

WHEREAS, as part of this arrangement, it was necessary for the Village to establish and for the Park District execute a plat of roadway dedication (Exhibit A) dedicating 1.63 acres of right-of-way in advance of the property transfer; and

SECTION 3: The Park Board hereby approves the plat attached as Exhibit A granting the roadway dedication that includes portions of Chippewa Trail as well as Niagra and Napa Streets, and the President and Secretary are authorized and directed to take such action and execute such plats and other documents as necessary perfect the dedication of the right of way.

The above named Sponsor hereby certifies and acknowledges that it has the sufficient funds necessary (includes cash and value of donated land) to complete the pending OSLAD project within the timeframes specified herein for project execution, and that failure to adhere to the specified project timeframe or failure to proceed with the project because of insufficient funds or change in local recreation priorities is sufficient cause for project grant termination which will also result in the ineligibility of the local project sponsor for subsequent Illinois IDNR outdoor recreation grant assistance consideration in the next two (2) consecutive grant cycles following project termination.

Acquisition and Development Projects

It is understood that the project must be completed within the timeframe established. The OSLAD timeframe is two years as is specified in the project agreement. The Billing Certification Statement must be submitted within 45 days of the grant expiration date and the last reimbursement request must be submitted within one year of the grant expiration date. Discussion: 2025 Merit Pool Recommendation

Agenda Item #6A

At the September 23, 2024 Board Meeting, we will be seeking approval for a 4% Merit Pool for the 2025 Budget. Below you will find information supporting this recommendation for the Board's consideration. Per the Salary Administration Policy & Procedure, the Board of Commissioners must annually approve the District's merit pool.

The state's mininimum wage will see another \$1 increase (7.14%) in January to \$15 per hour; this represents an aggregate increase of 81.8% from the \$8.25/hour minimum in 2018. Of the Districts 294 active employees, 255 are part-time, and 246 will see an increase due to the new minimum wage. As we have had to adjust minimum wage annually since 2018, we have had some unintentional compression to our full-time wage scale. That factor is considered in this recommendation.

Rationale for a 4% Merit Pool:

- 1. **Performance-Based Compensation:** The merit pool does not equate to an automatic salary increase. Instead, it is designed to reward employees who have demonstrated exceptional performance and contributed significantly to the organization's success. A 4% meirt pool would allow us to reward high-performing staff members appropriately and acknowledges their hard work, dedication, and achievements.
- 2. **Staff Retention and Recruitment:** In today's competitive job market, a 4% merit increase will help us stay competitive with agencies in our area and the recreation industry. Recruiting and retaining top talent is essential for the continued success of our District. Offering competitive wages is one of the key factors to attract and retain employees as well as reduce the costs and disruptions associated with high turnover rates.
- 3. **Organizational Impact:** Employees who feel valued and fairly compensated are more likely to be engaged and productive. Investing in our workforce through merit increases can lead to high morale, strong performance outcomes and overall success to the District.
- 4. **Financial Considerations:** We have reviewed our budget and financial forecasts to ensure that a 4% merit increase is feasible and sustainable. This adjustment will be implemented in a way that balance financial responsibility with our commitment to employee satisfaction.

Market Competitiveness:

- The Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) projects the national average for merit increases in 2025 as 3.5%.
- The table shows merit pool percentages from other park districts in our WDSRA group, along with several other neighboring agencies. Districts reporting TBD have a May-April Fiscal Year therefore their merit pool information is not yet available. We will update the table for the next board meeting with any new information that becomes available.
